From the Director

As 2021 came to an end we had some great challenges with staffing shortages but thanks to our amazing volunteers and Eli Schilling, our resale manager, we were able to make it through to the end!



Our Coalition resale shops had a fantastic year despite all the challenges with Covid. The team did a great job, as always. At the end of 2021 we were able to acquire a new box truck which should be completely assembled for us to use by Spring of 2022. This will allow us to increase our pick-ups and deliveries of furniture, pallets of food and other larger items. We were able to reseal the parking lots and re-route the traffic flow behind our resale shops to improve the flow of traffic through this area.

Though it was a bit smaller this year, our golf event at CCNC in August was a success raising over \$22,000 and at our Pack the Pick-up event that we had at our local Lowe's Foods locations we were able to collect over 350 bags of food during this event. Our client services office also saw a bit of a refresh, our parking lots were resealed and some siding was replaced on the building. We hope to add a loading dock and additional refrigeration space in 2022.

We continue to be greatly blessed by churches, The United Way and organizations throughout the county. Together with TeamWorkz on Thanksgiving Eve, we fed over 50 homeless adults and children at our Gilmore office. We will continue to work with local groups to learn more about the growing homelessness problem in the County.

Despite the challenging year, we were able to partner with the local food bank to provide food to Moore County seniors living with food insecurity, we currently deliver food to over 70 seniors each month. We remain true to our mission of helping struggling families in Moore County and our vision to lead the effort to achieve self-sustaining households. We will continue to explore new partnerships and initiatives to better assist those we serve.

Thank you again to our amazing volunteers, our dedicated staff and Board members! I know that 2022 will bring an opportunity for growth of new programs and services. We are looking forward to reaching out to areas of the county that need us the most and continue to expand services to seniors with food insecurity.
