From the Director

To say we had a busy year in 2022 would be an understatement. The dramatic increase in the cost of gasoline and food hit our clients very hard. We saw over 1,000 new clients in 2022! Our Board responded to the need by increasing the limits on food distribution from four times per year, to six times per year and financial assistance was increased from once per year to twice.



Our Coalition resale shops had another fantastic year, thanks to all the generous donations from the community. The team did a great job, as always. The box truck we put a deposit on at the end of 2021, did not arrive until the end of 2022, due to challenges with parts. We acquired a refrigerated box truck from Farm-to-Table that needs a bit of work, but that brings our fleet of box trucks to a total of three This allows us to increase our pick-ups and deliveries of furniture, pallets of food and other large items. We also added a scissor-lift and garage door at our client services building. This allows us to safely load/unload pallets and improve our efficiency dramatically.

Our partnership with the Food Bank allows us to deliver over 450 boxes of food to senior citizens living below the poverty line in the County each month, over 250 of them live in the Robbins area. We are working hard to expand our reach in the Robbins area, in hopes of creating a satellite Coalition there.

Our Pack-the-Pick-Up events at Lowe's Food and Harris Teeter were very successful. The Empty Bowls event is always very successful and we look forward to the next one in March of 2023.

We remain true to our mission of helping struggling families in Moore County and our vision to lead the effort to achieve self-sustaining households. We will continue to explore new partnerships and initiatives to better assist those we serve.

Thank you again to our amazing volunteers, our dedicated staff and Board members! I know that 2023 will bring more opportunities for growth of new programs and services. We are looking forward to reaching out to areas of the county that need us the most .


