2023 BY THE NUMBERS

How much of an impact does supporting the Coalition have in your community?

For the first half of 2023, more than 1,850 individuals came to the Coalition for assistance.

Food was distributed to more than 2,820 people. Clothing was provided to more than 1,570 people.

coming in. I pick up scheduled donations from homes and other locations in the Moore County area. I also deliver food boxes to senior citizens in need in all areas, including our newest delivery site in Robbins.

I enjoy working with the volunteers and other staff members to bring help to our Moore County communities. I am encouraged to see how much the community contributes to the Coalition, so together we can continue to reach out to help those that are in need. I am grateful for all the relationships that have been established with many that are a part of our community.



Director's Note

First let me say - Thank You to everyone who helps to support the Coalition. We could not do what we do without you!!

Thus far in 2023 we have seen a 68% increase in food distribution from our food pantry and a 47% increase in clothing distribution over last year. The "senior food box" program continues to grow. We have delivered over 2,550 boxes of food this year to the doorsteps of seniors in our county. Each box is enough food to last a week or more.

Our goal to reach out to the Northern part of the county is being fulfilled. We deliver food to San Juan Diego church the third Sunday of each month and are offering client services while we are there. Dental care has been a great need. We are working to find a location in the Robbins area that will permit us to have a permanent client services office to better serve this region of the county.
